


## **EMPOWERED WOMEN**

## Gro Harlem Brundtland

Former Prime Minister of Norway & Director-General of WHO IN APRIL, Gro Brundtland (Norwegian pronunciation: ['gru: 'ha':lem 'bruntlan:]; born Gro Harlem, 20 April 1939) is a Norwegian politician, who served three terms as the 29th prime minister of Norway (1981, 1986-89, and 1990-96) and as the director-general of the World Health Organization from 1998 to 2003. She is also known for having chaired the Brundtland Commission which presented the Brundtland Report on sustainable development. Educated as a physician, she became the first female Prime Minister of Norway serving three term between 1981-1996. She later became an international leader in sustainable development and public health, and served as Director-General of the World Health Organization and as UN Special Envoy on Climate Change from 2007 to 2010. Brundtland received the 1994 Charlemagne Prize, and has received many other awards and recognitions. She also successfully negotiated an agreement on tobacco control, increased access to life-saving drugs, worked towards polio eradication and promoted awareness of the link between poverty and disease Learn more about Brundtland: https://theelders.org/profile/groharlem-brundtland






## BOOK CLUB JUDITH HEUMANN

BEING HEUMANN: An
Unrepentant Memoir of a
Disability Rights Activist: This book is
groundbreaking on many levels. It is a touching
memoir of a woman paralyzed at a time when there
were no supports in place in our society to insure
equal rights for disabled.

A story of fighting to belong in a world that wasn't built for all of us and of one woman's activism—from the streets of Brooklyn and San Francisco to inside the halls of Washington—Being Heumann recounts Judy Heumann's lifelong battle to achieve respect, acceptance, and inclusion in society. Paralyzed from polio at eighteen months, Judy's struggle for equality began early in life. From fighting to attend grade school after being described as a "fire hazard" to later winning a lawsuit against the New York City school system, Judy's actions set a precedent that fundamentally improved rights for disabled people.
